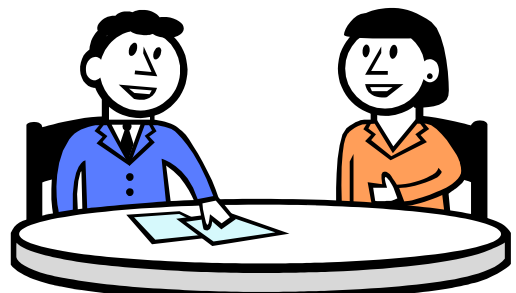

Pupil Premium and Support with Free School Meals and Clothing Grant

Please contact Mrs Scott-Collins in the school office if you think you might be eligible or you think your situation/income has changed since previously applying and may now be eligible.

Entitlement to Pupil Premium will give you access to a uniform grant and may give you subsidised access to Drop Zone, After School Club and Sports Club as school receives extra funding.

If you remain eligible when your child reaches Key Stage 2 they will receive free school meals.

Any queries please speak with Mrs Scott-Collins who is available Wednesday afternoon and all day Thursday and Friday.

Drop Zone and After School Club

Reminder we offer Drop Zone every morning from 8.20 a.m. £1.00 per child and 50p for siblings. There is no need to book in advance just arrive on the day.

We also offer After School Club every evening from 3.15 p.m to 5.45 p.m. This is split into sessions. One hour is £3.00, two hours, including a snack, would be £7.00 and the full session of two and a half hours is £8.50. Please book on ParentMail.

This half term we are challenging our families to produce an animal made from fruit or vegetables.

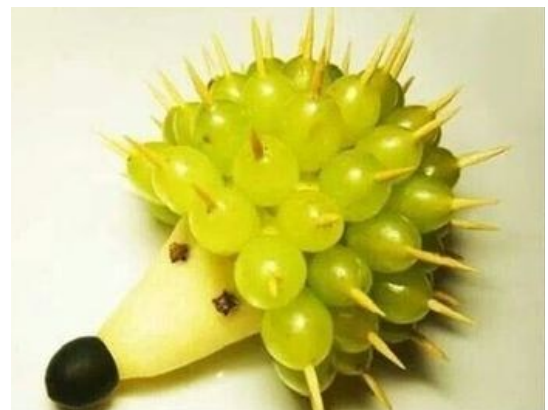
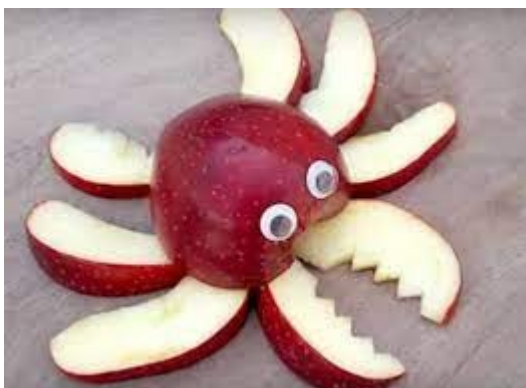
