Vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Country	Area of land with its own law/rules, separated with borders.
Town	A place where people work and live. Towns are larger than villages and smaller than cities.
Village	A group of houses, together with other buildings such as a church and a school in a country area.
United Kingdom	A country that includes England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales.
Aerial View	Looking down on an object from above like a bird.
Landmarks	A feature of a landscape that is easily seen and recognised from a distance.
Human feature	A man made landmark that is built by humans such as houses, lamp posts, post boxes etc.
Physical Feature	A natural feature on the surface such as water, mountains, desert etc.
