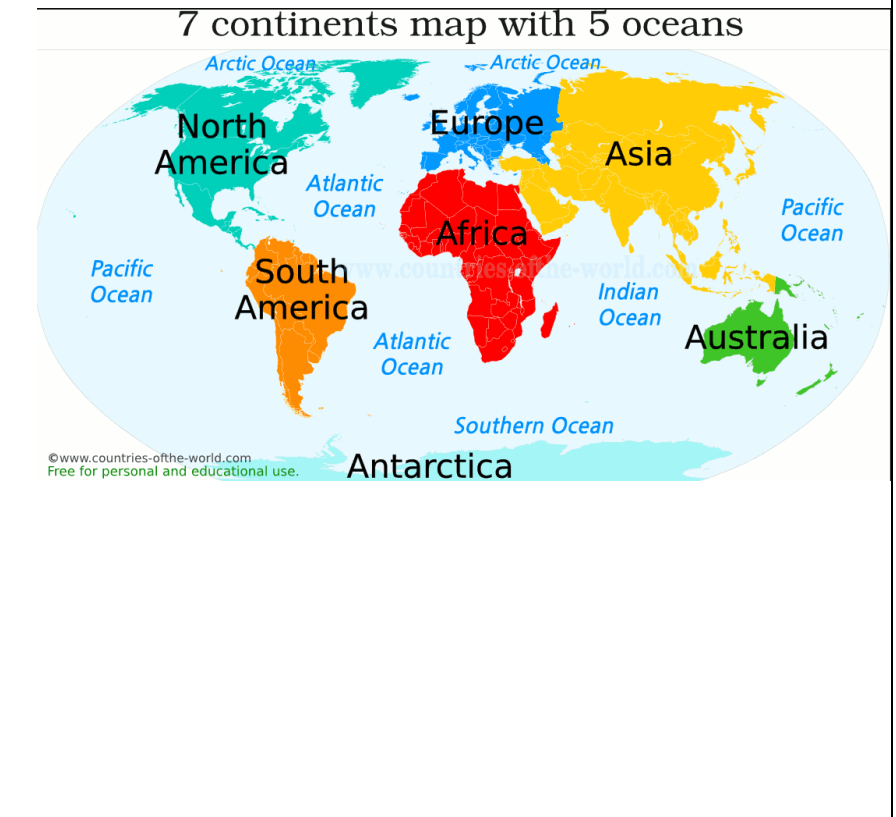

Word	Meaning
city	A large town is a city. London is a city.
compass point	Any of the main points of a compass: north, south, east and west.
continent	A very large area of land that consists of many countries. Europe is a continent .
country	An area of land that is controlled by its own government.
England	A country in the United Kingdom. Penrith is a town in England.
Equator	An imaginary line that divides the earth into two equal parts. The area around the equator is very warm. The North pole and the South pole.
island	A piece of land that is completely surrounded by water.
Great Britain	An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales.
North Pole and South Pole	The North Pole is the northernmost point of the Earth. The South Pole is the southernmost point of the Earth. The areas around the north and south poles are very cold.
Ocean	One of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface.
sea	A large area of salty water that is part of an ocean.
surrounded	To be present all around.
United Kingdom	The UK is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Island. It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

	<i>village</i>	A small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops that are often in the countryside. Pooley Bridge is a village.
