



What should I know already?	Diagram / Map / Photo etc...
<p>I know:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The town I live in is called Penrith.</li> <li>○ Penrith is in England, which is a country.</li> <li>○ The human and physical features of Penrith. <b>Human (houses, shops, parks, roads) and physical features (river, woodlands).</b></li> <li>○ The human features within the school grounds are a garden, pond, tarmac soft play, flower beds, buildings.</li> <li>○ Simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational directional language (near, far, left and right).</li> <li>○ The use of basic maps and aerial photographs.</li> </ul>	  
What will I know by the end of the unit?	
<p>I will know:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Human features can be found on an aerial photograph or map.</li> <li>○ Directional (and positional) language can be used to describe the location of features and routes on a map or photograph. For example the Jungle Garden is next to the football pitch. The bench is to the left of the flower pot.</li> <li>○ The simple compass directions north, south, east and west can be used to describe the where features are.</li> </ul>	
<b>Vocabulary</b>	
<b>Word</b>	<b>Meaning</b>
Human features	Features of the land built by humans. Roads, buildings and bridges.
Physical features	Natural features of the earth's surface. Rivers, mountains and forests.
Aerial view	A view from above
Map	A drawing of a particular area such as a city, a country or a continent
Compass	A tool for finding direction
Compass point	Any of the main points of a compass: north, south, east and west
Symbol	A picture that stands for something else
Key	Gives you the information needed for the map to make sense.
Direction	the path along which something moves, lies or points
Town	A large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work. Towns are larger than villages but smaller than cities.
City	A large town. London is a city.
