	Word	Meaning
Town	A place where people work and live. Towns are larger than villages and smaller than cities.	
Landmarks	A feature of a landscape that is easily seen and recognised from a distance.	
Human feature	A man made landmark that is built by humans such as houses, lamp posts, post boxes etc.	
Physical Feature	A natural feature on the surface such as water, mountains, desert etc.	
Past	A period of time that has already happened and gone by.	
Source	Provides information about the past.
