<i>Word</i>	<i>Meaning</i>
Author	A person who writes stories
Illustrator	An artist who draws pictures in a book or greetings cards.
Victorian	A person who lived when Queen Victoria was alive. The Victorian times were over 150 years ago.
Hill Top Farm	The Home of Beatrix Potter where she wrote lots of her books, using the animals she saw in her garden to create some of her characters.
Lake District	A place in the North West of England that has lots of mountains and Lakes.
Published	To print stories into books or newspapers to sell to people.
Conservation	To stop things being destroyed and trying to keep something alive or keeping something looking the same.
