Study Block: Who are Christians?

What should I know already?

- That people are unique and have different thoughts, ideas and interests.
- We belong to different groups, e.g. family, friends, school, class, teams etc.

What will I know by the end of the unit?

- I will begin know that there are different **religions** and I will begin to understand what this means.
- I will know that **Christianity** is a religion and people who believe in or follow this religion are called **Christians**.
- I will be able to talk about a person/people who are special to me.
- I will know that **Jesus** is a special person to Christians.
- I will begin to know that Christians believe **Jesus** was the Son of **God**, who is a special power that made and looks after the Earth and everything in it.
- I will begin to know that Christians believe God sent to Jesus to Earth to save mankind.
- I will begin to understand that the bible tells Christians that Jesus lived a long time ago, in the **past**.
- I will know that there are no photographs of Jesus, but people used clues in the **bible** to help them think about what he may have looked like.
- I will be able to talk about a book which is special to me.
- I will know that the **bible** is a sacred and holy book to Christians.
- I will be able to tell you that the bible has two parts, **the old testament** (first part, stories written before Jesus was born) and **the new testament** (second part, with stories about the life and death of Jesus).
- I will be able to retell some simple **miracles** to help me understand the power and significance of Jesus to Christians.
- I will retell some simple parables and talk about the meanings behind them and the lessons they teach Christians.

<i>Word</i>	<i>Meaning</i>
Religion	To believe in a God.
Christianity	Religion based on the life and teachings of Jesus.
Christian	Believer or follower of Christianity.
<i>Christians believe...</i>	
Jesus	The son of God who was sent to save mankind.
God	A special power, who made and looks after all things, but cannot be seen.
Bible	The sacred, holy book to Christians.
Holy	From God.
Sacred	Very special to Christians.
Old Testament	First part of the bible, with stories written before Jesus was born.
New Testament	Second part of the bible, telling stories about the life and death of Jesus.
Parable	A simple story told to teach a lesson.
Miracle	An extraordinary event that cannot be explained. Christians believe Jesus could perform them through the power of God.
